# Licensing Updates

- All licence terms and extent limits back to normal
- All HEIs signed extension to 2024
- BL 'pay CFP' pilot extended for this financial year
- New EHESS service charges from 1 August (on our website)
- Publisher-set per-chapter pricing for CFP scanning to be introduced for 2022 (no pricing details yet)
- No change to default article price for CFP: £22.50 for 2022

# DCS Updates

- The DCS is now used by 139 HEIs, and has seen almost 12 million student downloads since its launch, 3.2 million in the last year
- Student usage has been higher this year, even taking into account the increase in new HEI users. We have seen increases of between 10% and 100% for some weeks compared to the same week the previous year, averaging an increase of 23% for the entire academic year
- The Advanced Reader was launched 28 July as the DCS was moved to a CLA-operated Azure environment
- We are planning a new development to surface publishers' born-digital content in the DCS by mid-2022, with 60,000 publisher titles already lined up to be available as an alternative to EHESS or scanning
